## resource flowchart

The program has two major sections. Under the Main menu is support for users, both student and teacher, along with a list of possible socio-scientific issues to explore. In the Statement Builder, a user will work through the decision-making process. Here he or she will identify information, refine a statement, and evaluate the consequence of an action that is consistent with their chosen point of view for the issue selected.

The *Habitat in the Balance* program follows a recommended sequential order in keeping with the decision-making process. Charted below is the typical path that most users take. However, the program also allows for users to take a non-linear path through the Statement Builder, and/or to modify completed work, and still achieve a Report.
