## Share Your GREEN Schools Projects

Simply click on the Share your GREEN Schools Projects on the right side of the banner on the homepage. It is the third one in from the right. Fill in the blanks. ### Update Your GREEN Schools Data

Again, simply click on the Update your GREEN Schools Data on the right side of the banner on the homepage. It will be the second one in from the right. Fill in the blanks to update your data and don't forget to click on **Update NOW** at the bottom of the page. Once you do that, we can send you the appropriate certificate,


